Work is moving along on the exterior of the Hospital for Sick Children Research Institute in Toronto, Ont. EllisDon Corp. is general contractor of the 21-storey facility that is designed to meet LEED Gold certification. The building will be equipped with research labs, education and conference space, retail space and three levels of underground parking.
